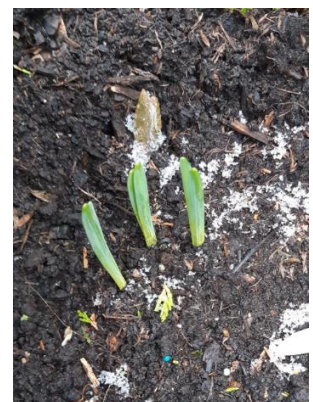


Wildlife Garden update!
