

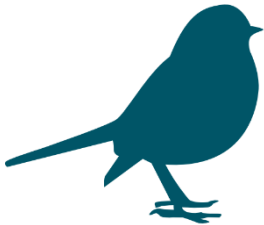

The Big RSPB Birdwatch

Every year the RSPB launch their annual Birdwatch. This is an opportunity for people all over the British Isles to watch, observe and record the birds that live in their local area. This then helps the RSPB have a clearer idea of exactly how the populations of different birds are doing around

the UK.

The dates this year are **24th-26th January** and the RSPB ask that you spend **just one hour** watching and recording the birds- this can be in a garden, a park, from a balcony or a back yard- you could even watch from a window.



When you have recorded the birds you have seen, you simply go online to submit the species that you saw- www.rspb.org.uk/birdwatch

On Thursday 23rd, your child will come home with a recording sheet- this will help you to identify the birds you might see and provide a place to record them.

TOP TIP: It helps to put a little food out where you are watching, then you will probably see more birds!
