- The effective work of your clerk who has a leading role in ensuring that the Board has appropriate focus that results in impact.

In all Governor Mark assessments, there are some suggested areas for improvement, to support ongoing development. In your case the governing body is highly effective and our recommendations are to:

- Consider how the excellent work of the governing board can be articulated to report more powerfully the impact that the Board has on pupils' education and life in school in its broadest sense.
- As recognised by the Board recruit/develop governors with an appropriate finance skill set.
