

What should I do if I'm worried about a child?

If you have concerns about a child's welfare you have a duty to report your concerns. The concerns may well be about one incident or concerns that you have in general.

Your concerns can be reported in two ways:-

- Ask at the school office to speak with Mrs Browne (Headteacher), who is the school's designated child protection officer and safeguarding lead. Mrs Browne can also be contacted on 01303 255400 or headteacher@st-peters-folkestone.kent.sch.uk
- If you feel unable to approach the school about your concerns, you should report to Social Services by calling 03000 411111. This can be done anonymously if you are worried about disclosing your identity.
