

## SCHOOL REWARD AND BEHAVIOUR SYSTEM

### RED TED

RED TED is our reading reward system and is fully embedded into school life; the system is used from Reception class all the way through to Year 6. Remember RED TED stamps mean prizes; children collect a RED TED stamp every time they read at home with an adult, which is signed off in their RED TED book!

50 stamps = RED TED Bear

100 stamps = Book

200 stamps = Book + Badge

300 stamps = Book + Wrist Band

400 stamps = Book + Pencil Case

500 stamps = Trip to Waterstones

For every further 100 stamps collected children will receive a £5.00 gift voucher.

### Behaviour Chart

We have a reward chart that is displayed in each classroom that is used daily to reward and address pupils' behaviour. Even though this chart is based in the classroom it can be used to reward or address children's behaviour while they are outside during playtimes, in the dining hall or on trips. It is a graduated system and is used consistently throughout the school. A child may only go up or down the chart in one step intervals *unless* their behaviour has been extreme and they may then go straight to red. School Council agreed that breaking the online safety rules would result in children moving straight to RED (agreed May 2015).

PLATINUM - Letter home to parents with certificate and platinum sticker.

DOUBLE GOLD - Two gold stickers.

GOLD - Single gold sticker.

GREEN - Starting point for everyone every day and expected minimum behaviour level.

YELLOW - Teacher warning.

ORANGE - Time out in own or another class for 10 minutes.

RED - Child will be sent straight to the Headteacher and a phone call home to parents. The headteacher will decide on the most appropriate sanction.

### **Winnie's Winners**

Winnie's winners stamps work in conjunction with the behaviour system. Children receive 1 stamp for reaching gold, two stamps for reaching double gold and three stamps for reaching platinum. Each child has a Winnie's winners card with 30 spaces, which they stamp with a dog paw for each stamp achieved. Once they have completed their card, they get to choose a prize from Winnie's prize box!

Once the card is full, the children will receive a new one and start collecting for another reward.

### **House System**

All children are allocated to a house when they start school.

### **Celebration Assembly**

Every Monday we have a celebration assembly where we give out various awards.

Headteacher Awards are given to children who have been highlighted by the Class Teacher as having achieved well in the previous week or for excellent attitude and behaviour.

### **Good Choice Marble Jar**

Every class decides on their 'good choice'. The children try hard throughout the week to demonstrate the 'good choice' and if achieved will be given a marble for their jar. When the jar is full, then the class will receive a treat!
