

St Peter's School Uniform Policy – Reviewed July 2024

At St Peter's we aim to instil a sense of 'Pride' in our children and this includes the uniform that they wear that represents our school. Whilst we understand that there may be times when part of a child's uniform is missing we cannot accept poor attention to our uniform guidelines on a regular basis. If there is a problem with an article of clothing (eg broken shoes that need to be replaced, lost ties) we expect parents/carers to inform us of this and replace the missing items as soon as possible. If appropriate uniform is not worn and parents have not notified us of this a text may be sent to parents/carers, followed by a letter and possible meeting with the headteacher if the issue does not resolve itself.

Where a child does not have their PE Kit, we will provide a spare one in the first instance and text the parents/carers to request that the kit is sent in. If the kit is still not provided we will send a letter home and as a last resort we may contact the parents for a meeting to discuss this.

At St. Peter's, we aim to promote each child's right to express their gender and personality in whichever way feels right for them. To support this aim, our uniform policy is gender neutral. This means that, whilst we expect all of our

children to wear school uniform, the rules for boys and girls are the same and we do not insist that they wear specific items of clothing.

Skirt / Dress Uniform

Grey Pinafore dress, skirt, grey shorts or trousers

White Shirt (short sleeve)

Tie

OR

Blue and white check summer dress (NO TIE TO BE WORN WITH SUMMER DRESS).

Dark or White socks (Ankle or Knee length)

Black shoes (NO TRAINERS, PLIMSOLLS OR SANDALS)

Shorts / Trouser Uniform

Grey/Black trousers or shorts

White Shirt (Short Sleeve)

Tie

Black/Grey socks

Black Shoes (NO TRAINERS or PLIMSOLLS)

PE KIT FOR ALL CHILDREN (see picture below)

Royal Blue Shorts (NOT CYCLING SHORTS OR THOSE WITH A LOGO)

Royal Blue T-shirt (with the St Peter's Logo)

Plimsolls or trainers

School Tracksuit with Logo (for the Winter months)

PE kit will need to be purchased from Channel Uniforms.



PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM ARE NAMED SO THAT WE ARE ABLE TO RETURN ANY LOST ITEMS.

Uniform with the logo on can be bought from Channel Uniforms in Folkestone as can all items of the PE kit. We also run a second hand uniform stall several times throughout the year.

Parents' ability to afford school uniform must not put children at a disadvantage, therefore where parents are not able to afford to purchase school uniform, they should speak to the Headteacher about what support may be available.
